



## Mike Napier's Biography

Mike Napier will serve as the Interim Administrator for the Department of Health in Osceola County beginning Friday, March 30, 2018. Mike has served as Administrator for the Department of Health in Pasco County since December 2012 and will remain in this role during his interim status at DOH-Osceola.

For nearly 30 years Mike's public health career has spanned two states and nine county health departments. Beginning in upstate New York while attending college he worked as a seasonal health inspector for three summers. Mike moved to Florida in 1986 and began working at DOH-Orange and then DOH-Osceola as a health inspector until 1993 when he became the Business Manager for DOH-Osceola. He then served as the Administrator for DOH-Seminole from 2004 through 2012 before accepting the position as Administrator for DOH-Pasco.

Mike has previously held the position of president for the Florida Association of County Health Officers, Florida Public Health Association and the Florida Association of County Health Department Business Administrators. He holds an associate degree in biology from the State University of New York at Cobleskill, a Bachelor of Professional Studies degree from Barry University, and a Master of Science degree in health sciences from the University of Central Florida.
